WHISKEYTOWN RECAP

Amazing. Awesome. Insane. Ridiculous. Wide open. Those are just some of the words to describe the Kokanee action during Kokanee Power's inaugural event, which took place on June 4th. Nestled in Shasta County about 8 miles west of Redding, it has been home to one of the hottest Kokanee bites in the state leading up to the event, and it lived up to the expectation.

On the morning of June 4th, more than 110 participants piled into their boats, set out their favorite Kokanee setups tipped with corn that was soaking in their secret recipe, and sent them down into the clear waters of Whiskeytown in search of quality Kokanee that would put them up on the leaderboard. The catching started immediately and did not slow down as the day progressed. There was so much action for participants that the name of the game started to become what lure would not get bit. Some anglers joked around that even a bare hook would have caught fish. It was a day of catching, not fishing.


At the end of the day, quality 13 to 14 inch Kokanee were caught and brought to the scales making for some tight weights among participants. However, there were some exceptional Kokanee caught including one caught by Butch and Chris Jacobson that measured nearly 16.75" long. That fish solidified the win for them with a total of 48.95 ounces for their best three fish.

ALMANOR CANCELLED

Lake Almanor is a wonderful lake and an amazing fishery that has beautiful Rainbow Trout, Brown Trout, and Landlocked King Salmon. Every year, many of our members look forward to making the drive and spending some time on this beautiful lake, catching some quality trophy fish while helping support local businesses and the fishery.

Our 5th annual fishing derby was scheduled for August 6, 2016. All proceeds from our derby fund the necessary fish food for the Almanor trophy trout pen program located at the Hamilton Branch. Recently, after making a few phone calls to our partners in the derby, several circumstances were brought to our attention which have put the event in jeopardy. Particularly, our main contributing partner has withdrawn from the derby for personal reasons beyond our control. This in turn has resulted in the loss of our event venue, food provision, and major contributing sponsor. With such a considerable loss, this does not give us ample time to acquire a new venue, acquire the appropriate permits, schedule a new caterer, and notify participants of the change in venue. Kokanee Power has a commitment to the members, derby participants, the local businesses and communities around Lake Almanor, and our partners at PG&E and the Almanor Fishing Association (AFA) to host and run a fun-filled, well-organized event. After a lengthy discussion and consideration by our Officers and Board Members, it was unanimously decided with deep regret to cancel the event until 2017.

Kokanee Power is currently assessing the situation further and pursuing plans to ensure the event in 2017 is a success.
